Weed Management Plan Template

(For use with Planning and Zoning)

- 1. Aerial photograph of property and vicinity map
 - Can get off of Google earth
 - Lemhi County weed control
- 2. Inventory of property for Idaho and County listed noxious weeds
 - During winter months a statement of intent to do so during the spring will suffice
 - An identification booklet will be provided by Lemhi County if needed at no charge
 - The Lemhi County Weed Superintendent will help with on identification and on site visits at no charge.
- 3. Explanation of how noxious weeds will be treated
 - This can be the use of mechanical, herbicide or biological control agents
 - County weed control can provide recommendations
- If property is to large to feasible treat all infestations within one growing season, a multi year management plan may be submitted.
- A time frame needs to be included as to when inventory will be completed and when treatment will be completed.
- 6. A weed management plan is not required if:
 - No noxious weeds are present (verified by County weed superintendent).
 - The weed management plan does not need to be followed if the property is sold during winter dormancy within a period of one winter.
 - Control methods approved by the County weed superintendent occur prior to planning and zoning request.
- A disclaimer stating that if the weed management plan is not followed that an enforcement ticket will be issued.
